Building Finance Team Update

We invite you each to prayerfully consider how God is leading you to give towards the Building Project. A special Building Fund Offering was received last Sunday. If you missed this giving opportunity, you are still welcomed to participate, if desired. You can do so by placing checks or envelopes earmarked "Building Fund" in the offering boxes outside of the sanctuary at any time. You can also give online through [Tithe.ly](https://www.tithe.ly), and selecting the Building Fund option.

Two Financial surveys were placed in mailboxes and were also sent out electronically. One survey's purpose is to gauge the amount that you feel God is calling you to give as cash down prior to moving dirt (this should exclude any giving that you plan to give today).

As a reminder, based on the figures presented, approximately \$550,000 is still needed prior to being able to break ground. Divided among 100 family units, this equates to an average of \$5,500 from each family unit. The other survey's purpose is to gauge the amount that you feel that God is calling you to lend to the church. Please return both surveys to Jewel Peachey by August 6.

For the summer months of corporate prayer, the prayer team is encouraging you to pray for your neighbors, take time to walk or drive through your neighborhood praying for people who live there, engage people in conversation if possible, get creative in connecting with those who live near you who you may not know.
