- ▶ **Garrett & Kaitlin Byler** - Sunday School

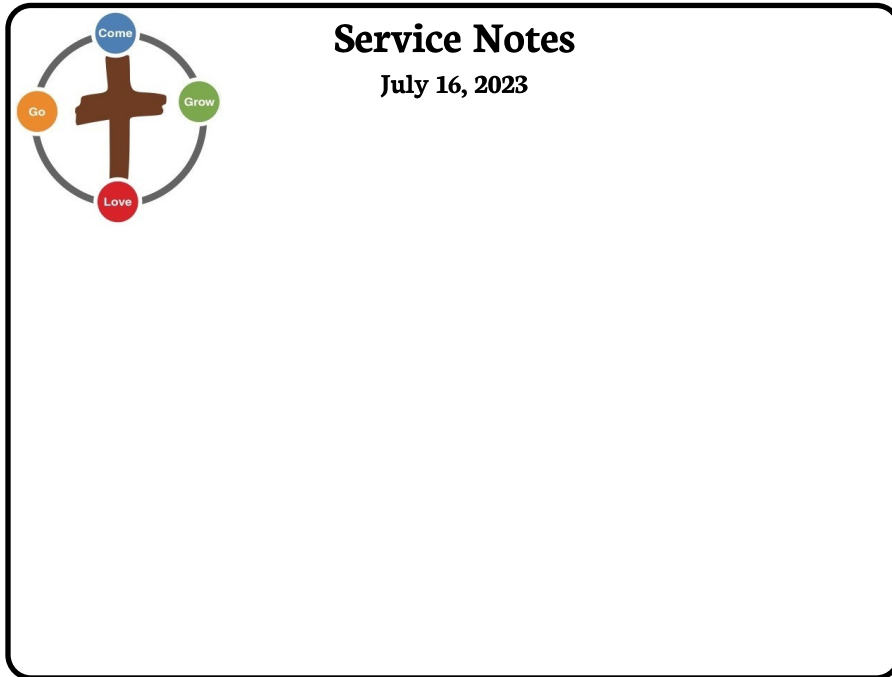

Building Finance Team Update

We invite you each to prayerfully consider how God is leading you to give towards the Building Project. A special Building Fund Offering will be received on July 30.

Two Financial surveys will be placed in mailboxes today and will also be sent out electronically. One survey's purpose is to gauge the amount that you feel God is calling you to give as cash down prior to moving dirt (this should **exclude** any giving that you plan to give on July 30).

As a reminder, based on the figures presented, approximately \$550,000 is still needed prior to being able to break ground. Divided among 100 family units, this equates to an average of \$5,500 from each family unit. The other survey's purpose is to gauge the amount that you feel that God is calling you to lend to the church. Please return both surveys to Jewel Peachey by August 6.
